Under the Autonomous examination set up Academic calendar for the academic year 2017-18 was prepared as per the schedule given by the parent university Vikrama simhapuri University, Nellore. Examination calendar of the year 2017-18 was prepared which notifies scheduled dates of INTERNALS, PRACTICALS AND SEMESTER END EXAMINATIONS. Semester end examination were conducted after receiving **BOS** copies from all departments and as per syllabi and model papers question prepared were called from various Autonomous Government College across the start. After Completion of 90 Instructional days Semester end examination are scheduled and before 20 days of examination, the notification was released.

Moderation by Grafting was introduced with the approval of Academic Council. Grafting is a procedure in which the individual who got less marks than aggregate in one paper will be adjusted with a maximum of 3 marks from the high scored paper of that student.

1. The maximum number of marks that can be transferred from any donor paper is 3 marks only.
2. The transfer of marks will be allowed from theory to theory or from practical to practical papers.
3. Grafting is allowed within the parts only.
 - a) Part A = Languages
 - b) Part B = Subjects
 - c) Part C= Foundation courses

Under moderation nearly 13 students were benefited in the semester end examinations April 2017. Institutional average pass percentage is 68%. In this year Automation is introduced for smooth conduct of autonomous examinations.

The students should put in at least 75% of attendance to be eligible to sit for the semester end examinations. A student cannot be promoted for next semester unless he pays the required examination fee, even though he puts in the required percentage of attendance. The Principal can relax the attendance eligibility by 5% for those students who could not attend the classes due to ill health. As per the resolutions of Staff council it is resolved to allow students those who have less than 75% of attendance in the range of 60% to 75% are allowed to attend the semester End examinations on paying condonation fee.
