**PRINCIPAL'S ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2012-13**

Good Evening and a warm welcome to Esteemed Invitees!

I take honour in extending my invitation to the eminent academician, Chief Guest of today's function, Prof. G. Rajaramireddy, Vice-Chancellor, V.S. University, Tirupati to the Print and Electronic Media, to our well wishers of Nellore City to teaching and non-teaching staff of the college to the 49<sup>th</sup> Annual Day Celebration of D.K. Govt. College for Women, Nellore. Let me inform you here that the college is entering its golden jubilee year in the following academic year i.e 2013-2014 and with the support from all of you we wish to conduct various programmes to mark the occasion.

I'm privileged, yet another time, to present the college Annual Report for the academic Year 2012-2013.

Dodla Kousalyamma College for Women is the precious gift of Smt. D. Kousalyamma, with whose initiation the college was established in 1964 and flourished into the present state of educating more than a thousand girl students from across all the sections of the society not just from in and around Nellore but also from all the neighbouring districts.

This only government college in town as well as the only Govt. Women's College in the district offers 12 undergraduate courses and three Postgraduate Courses. The Conventional courses are M.P.C, B.Z.C and Home Science in B.Sc., H.E.P, E.P.T in B.A, and B.Com General. The Re-structured courses are Biotechnology, Micro Biology, M.P.CS, M.S.CS, in B.Sc., Communicative English in B.A., and Computer Applications in B.Com. The Post Graduate Courses offered in the College are M.A in Telugu, M.A in English and M.Sc in Zoology. After the Reaccreditation by NAAC with an A grade in 2011 the college is prepared to go for Autonomy status and all the necessary papers are submitted to the UGC in December 2012 in this regard. The college is awaiting the inspecting team from the UGC.

The college commenced its academic activity on June , 2012 as per the academic schedule of V.S. University to which the College is affiliated to. A total of 331 students joined in various first year undergraduate courses, with a majority of 179 students joining in Science courses. 79 and 72 students joined in Arts and Commerce respectively.

### **Results:**

The college achieved 55 % of Passes in undergraduate Courses with 43% of classes and 25% of second classes in the University exams held in March/April 2012. In PG courses the result is 100 % with 65% first classes and 32% second classes.

### **New Recruitment:**

The college is happy to get constant support from the govt. in the form of appointments given to qualified staff through fresh recruitment and placing them in our college Dr. Mehaboob Mohammad, Lecturer in Urdu, Ms.K. Sai Sudha, Lecturer in Bio-technology, Dr. S. Divija Devi, Lecturer in Telugu and Smt. R. Vijaya Kumari, Lecturer in Computer Science are recruited through APPSC. Mrs. A. Naga Symala, Lecturer in Statistics (on Contract Basis) and Ms. Gayathri lecturer in Botany(on contract basis) joined the departments this year. Mr. Sk. Masthan Basha, joined as Attender on recruitment.

### **Promotions:**

I am happy to share with you the professional growth of my colleagues. Dr. N.V. Lakshmi, Lecturer in Home Science is promoted as Principal, GDC(W), Adilabad. Sri. V. Nagaraju, Record Assistant of the college is promoted as Junior Assistant, Sri. Penchlaiah, Sri. M. Venkateswarlu, Smt. Hemalatha Daniel, Sri. Vinod Kumar are promoted as Record Assistants.

### **Transfers:**

The college is further strengthened with the addition of teaching and non teaching staff on transfer. Dr. K. Padmaja, Lecturer in English, Sri Rajeswar Reddy, Lecturer in Physics and Sri. Prabhakar, Lecturer in Chemistry joined on transfer from GDC, Gudur. Smt. Sk. Almas Begum, Lecturer in Hindi is transferred to our college from GDC, Sullurpet. Similarly Sri. Lokanadham, Attender joined us on transfer from GDC, Gudur.

The college also saw people leaving her this year either on transfer or on retirement.

Sri. K. Subramanyam, Superintendent was transferred to GDC, Chirala. Sri Sk. Sabjan, Lecturer in Physics was transferred to GDC, Kovur. Sri. Bhaskar Reddy, Lecturer in Commerce was repatriated to Sarvodya College, Nellore.

The College lost two great lecturers on retirement. Miss A. Lalithamba, Lecturer in Botany, retired on 31-12-2012 and Sri K. Bala Babu, Lecturer in Commerce, retired on 31-01-2013. Similarly Dr. K. Eswaramma, Contract Lecturer in Telugu, Mrs. P. Martha Madhuri, Contract Lecturer in Bio – Technology left college by disturbance due to DL recruitment through APPSC.

### **Distinctions:**

Dr. Y. Dayakar, Reader in Zoology is honoured with the **Best Teacher** award by the State Government of A.P. on September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2012.

Dr. K. Padmaja, Lecturer in English is awarded a certificate in English Language assessment by the **University of Maryland, U.S.A.** in June, 2012 for her participation in 10 week on line course and passing out with 97%.

Ms. A. Lalithamaba lecturer in Botany received S.C Dikshit prize instituted by Indian Botanical Society for her research paper entitled “Macrofitic diversity of wetlands of Nellore.”

Dr. Y. Dayakar, Reader in Zoology, Dr. B. Krishna Murthy, Lecturer in Commerce and Sri. Prabhakar, Lecturer in Chemistry are chosen to be Academic Auditors by the CCE and they conducted Academic Audits at various Govt. Degree Colleges across the state.

Dr. K. Padmaja, was appointed as Master Trainer for training fellow English Lecturers in a week long training programmes at GDC, Chittoor and GDC(W), Guntur in August and September, 2012 respectively.

### **N.C.C:**

Dr C. Kalapriya Lecturer in Home science is in charge of NCC. The college NCC unit has 100 cadets, seven of our cadets are selected for the National Integration Camp at Rajasthan and two cadets are selected for Pre Republic day camp. Ch Manemma won gold medal in songs competition in CATC camp at Tirupathi. Ch Manemma and M Govindamma got silver medals A.P directorate drill test and in Volley ball at CATC camp respectively. The NCC cadets participated in blood donation camps and took part in AIDS awareness rally, Cancer awareness rally and Save Electricity drive. All these cadets are prepared to take B and C exams in February 2013.

### **N.S.S:**

The College N.S.S unit has 110 volunteers. Smt Y. Ravindramma, Lecturer in Physical Education, is the programme officer. D.Sushma of II B.com is selected for Republic day training at Nagapur for 10 days in 2012.

### **Sports and Games:**

17 students are selected for inter university games and sports competitions. An inter collegiate games and athletic meet for men and women

and zonal level games and athletic meet for men and women were organized at our college

### **Student Achievements:**

The college conducted Literary, Cultural and other Competitions in connection with many occasions nearly in ten events at college and district level. Reshma Mishra of I B.A. (H.E.CE.) won State first prize in English and Hindi Elocution as part of state level Youth festival. Ms. Sk. Shahina Begum of III B.Com. secured first Prizes in elocution at State Level as part of Consumer club activity and in AIDS Awareness Programme, as part of Red Ribbon Club activity. She also received district level first prizes in elocution in Voters day competitions, in youth festival and in Bio Diversity. G.Saraswathi of III B.Com got state II prize as part of consumer club activity and state first prize as part of AIDS awareness programme. Ms. B. Swapna of III B.Com. (C) got state first Prize in essay writing in consumer awareness programme. Ms. P. Amara Jyothi of III B.A. (H.E.CE.) got First Prize in Elocution in English and Ms. D. Seetha of II B.A. (H.E.P.) got First Prize in Telugu Elocution and Ms. P. Sunanda of III B.Com. (C) got First Prize in Singing in World Braille Day Competitions held at District Level. Our III B.A. (H.E.CE.) students secured First Prize in Group Discussion & Project Report at District Level as part of World Braille Day Competitions.

Under the DRC activity departments of Political Science and Economics conducted Mock Parliament and familiarized the future citizens of the nation with the way in which the parliamentary procedures are conducted.

### **Women empowerment cell:**

The women empowerment cell of the college has celebrated International Women's day on March 8<sup>th</sup> 2012. It has organized awareness programmes on legal rights and Acts related to women's problems with the help of the district legal education cell. It also organized an awareness programme on atrocities on women in the back drop of Delhi rape incident on 16-12-12.

### **Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Open University:**

Our study center for women is offering contact programmes for 490 students with 70 students in first year and 210 students each in second and third years. Smt. K. Audishesamma lecturer in Botany is the Coordinator .

### **Hostel:**

The student managed college hostel, which is located behind the college building, has 6 blocks with 113 rooms. The total number of inmates is 677 of which 392 belong to Schedule Castes, 40 to Scheduled Tribes, 178 to Backward Classes. Smt K.Audishesamma, Lecturer in Botany is the Deputy Warden of the Hostel.

### **Donations:**

Dr. N. Prema Sagar Reddy, U.S.A has donated an amount of Rs./ 60 lakhs. for the construction of 4 rooms and the construction is completed.

### **Problems:**

Despite the achievements that we are able to place on record here before you the college is facing problems in these areas. In view of the severe power shortage the college would like to become self sufficient in generating power at least to some extent and also create green energy by opting for solar power



system and the college requests the support of philanthropists and the authorities in the initial establishment of the equipment for this purpose. Similarly in a women's college with more than 1000 students and staff the bathroom facilities are severely disproportionate in number and we request the support of authorities in the construction of the bath rooms too.
