In the discussion the following aspects are considered for the BOS approval, which is scheduled on 3rd Sep 2022.

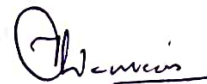
1. Approval syllabus in respect of Vth/VIth Semesters

Now the classes are scheduled only for 3rd Semesters of various groups.

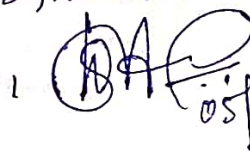

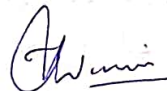
MINUTES OF THE BOS HELD ON 03-09-2022

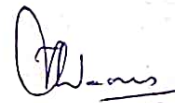

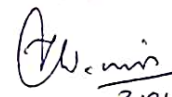
