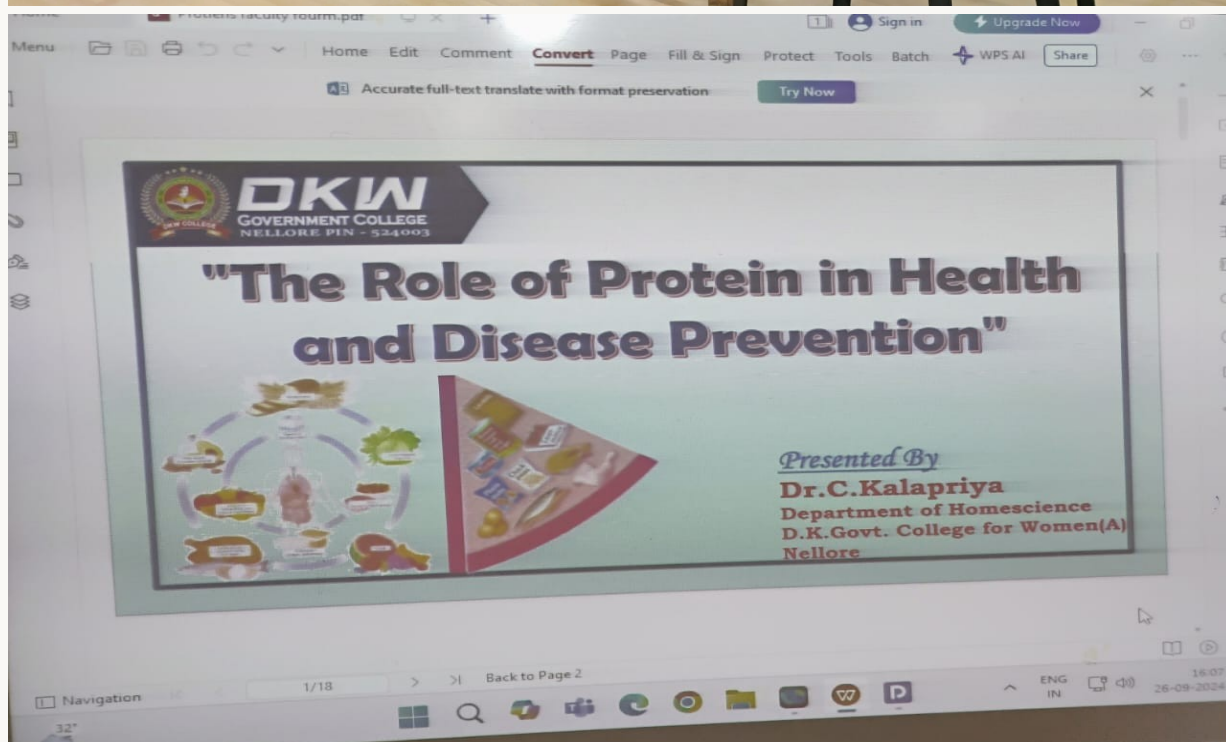
## Field Visit for Aquaculture students

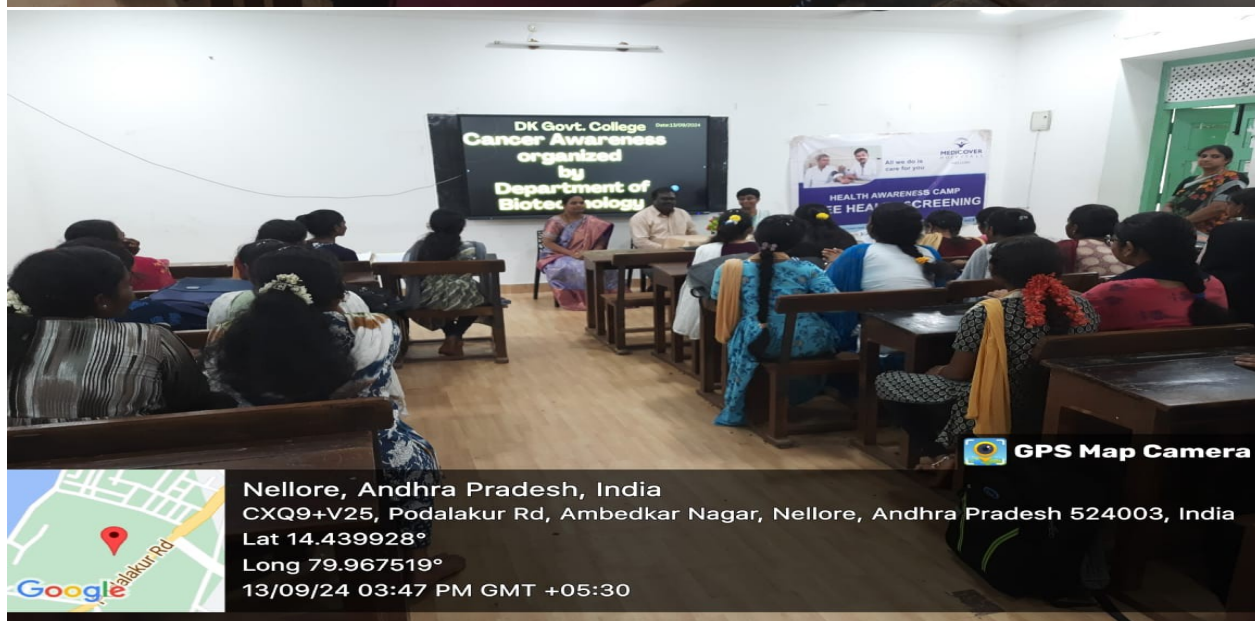
**Historical Study Tour organized by the Dept. of History**
