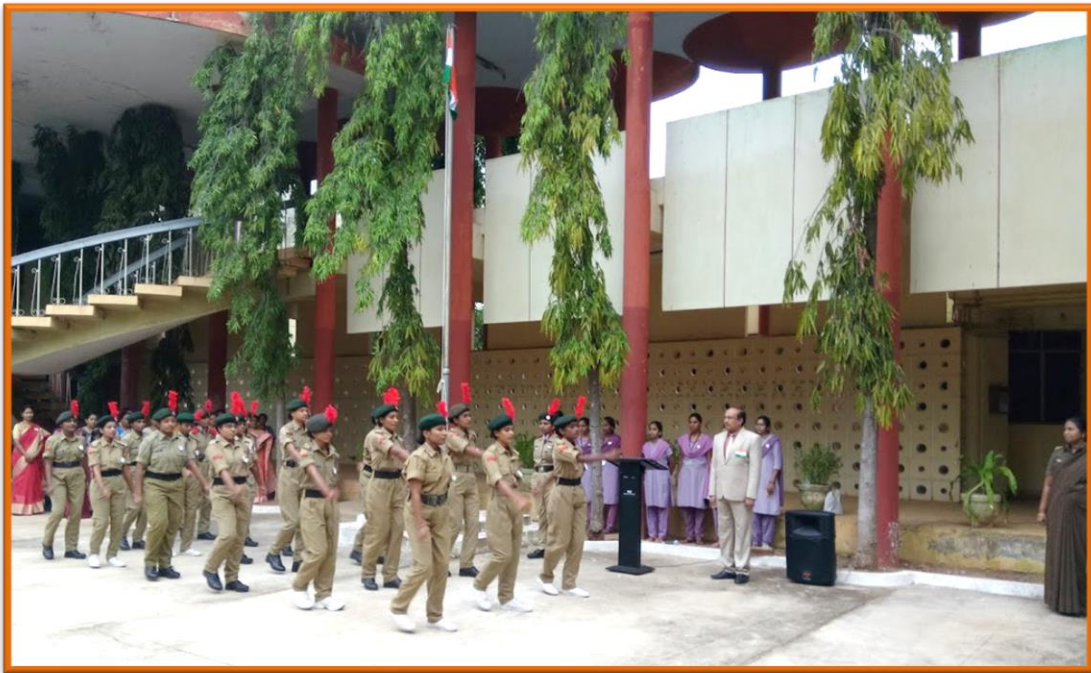


INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY
