COMBINED ANNUAL TRAINING CAMP - IV

Combined Annual Training Camp – IV was conducted in NCC Nagar, Tirupati from 20-06-2018 to 29-06-2018. 30 vacancies were allotted to our college. The basic aim of Camp is to introduce cadets to a regimented way of life and helps in developing camaraderie, team work, leadership qualities, self-confidence, self-reliance and dignity of labour in the cadets. The cadets are exposed to the excitement of camp life where they apply the theoretical knowledge that they had gained in Institutional Training. It is mandatory for Junior Division/ Junior Wing cadets to attend at least one camp and Senior Division/ Senior Wing cadets to attend a minimum of two camps during the period of their enrolment. Cadets were trained in firing, foot drill , weapon drill, classes on personality development , health and hygiene and self defence techniques are taught. Cadets K.Sushma swarupa, A.Usha and Y.Manogna were awarded prizes for NCC written examination and sports. Cadet G.Prathyusha has donated blood. Also other cadets participated in cultural programme and international yoga day in camp itself and all the cadets were issued camp certificates.

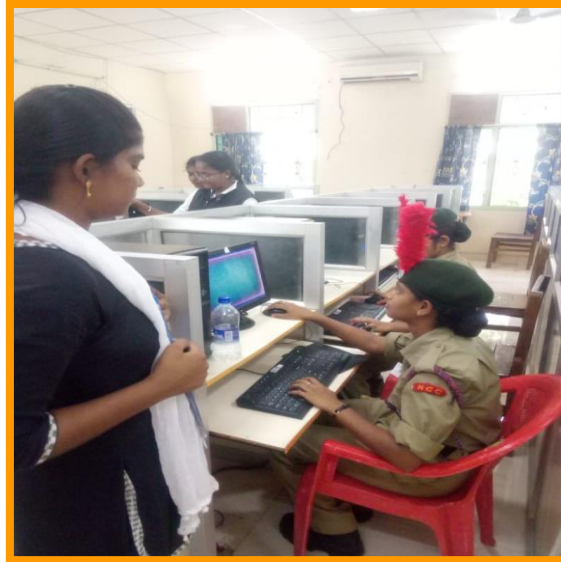
AWARENESS PROGRAM ON GANDHIAN PRINCIPLES
