

Report on NSS Special Mega Camp

During the academic year 2016-17 NSS units I, II, III of D.K.Govt. Degree College for Women (A), Nellore with 150 Volunteers organised a special Mega Camp in Adopted Village, Amancharla from 1-09-2017 to 03-09-2017 and in our college from 04-09-2017 to 07-09-2017. The volunteers of NSS Units I, II, and III performed many activities like House hold Survey, Medical camp, awareness Programmes on Cancer, Vaccinations, Literacy, construction and repair of road, cleanliness, Plantation etc.,

Day 1:- (Inaugural function & House hold survey)-01-09-2017

On the first day of the camp 150 NSS Volunteers rallied out the streets of the village to create awareness among the villagers about the ensuring special mega camp programme in their village. After, that an inauguration programme held at M.P.P.School in Amamcharla Village, the chief Guest Dr.Ch.Masthanaiah garu, Principal of D.K.Govt. Degree College for Women (A), Nellore. Mrs.Anasuya Garu MPTC and Sri Ratnam Garu Sarpanch of the Village, Mr. Varaprasad, Village Secretary and other villagers were invited by NSS. P.O's. The Inaugural speech was delivered by the Principal, Emphasised the role of NSS in the Community service. The special guest, Smt. Anasuyamma garu, MPTC and Sri.Ratnam Garu Sarpanch of the village heartily welcomed the team of NSS Volunteers, and assured them all sorts of co- operation needed in making the special camp a success.

In the afternoon session, the Volunteers divided into some teams, and the teams interacted with village people. Volunteers started house hold survey by contacting the villagers in the leadership of NSS P.O's and discussed about their needs and required meats. They also created awareness on mal effects of open defecation, untidiness, contagious deseases, etc;; . Volunteers covered more than 350 houses and collected the data. This type of work would involve the students to understand the socio economic back ground of the village.









Day 2: (Medical camp & Swatch Bharath)-02-09-2017

On the second day of the special mega camp, "an awareness programme on cancer and medical camp" was organised in the village. Dr. Varaprasad, co.ordinator, Cancer hospital, Nellore and some other staff of the hospital were invited. Dr. Varaprasad addressing villagers and our students, clarified the misconceptions regarding cancer and it can be cured by using the technology developed. He also explained about the preventive measures. After the medical check up for villagers, vaccination for the children was conducted. NSS Volunteers helped in vaccinating the children.

After lunch, NSS volunteers started to clean the school premises and some lanes of the village as the part of "Swatchya Bharath" programme. In the evening some competitions, Group discussions and some recreation programmes were conducted. Volunteers shared their ideas and views with enthusiasm.











<u>Day 3:-(</u> Shramadanam & Plantation)-03-09-2017

The third day of the camp began with **Shramadanam** under "Vanam Manam" as Harithandra Pradesh, Cleaned the roads removed grass and dust and laid the roads with some trucks of soil and levelled. After that volunteers planted some plants in the School premises.

In the following session volunteers dug the pits for plants along both sides of roads. Nearby 150 saplings were collected from nearby nurseries and planted them throughout the village under the guidance of the programme officers. Smt.Anasuya MPTC, Sri Ratnam, Sarpanch also participated in the programme. Village people appreciated the volunteers and pleased at our work. Volunteers explained the villagers how to protect the plants.

NSS PO's Smt.D.Surendra, Dr.S.Divija Devi and Sri.K.Joji thanked MPTC, Sarpanch and all the villagers for their co-operation. Then volunteers returned to the college by evening 6.30pm.







Day 4: (Medical Check-up & Blood Donation)-04-09-2017

Masthanaiah and all teaching and non teaching staff participated in the programme. Addressing the students, principal educated the importance of blood donation to them. He also encouraged them to donate blood. Dr.Deepthi, chief medical officer IRCS, B. Bhaskar Rao, Motivator IRCS, Nellore, Dr.Hari Babu, IRCS, Nellore participated in the programme. Doctors checked up B.P, Weight, Blood Group and percentage of haemoglobin in blood for the staff members and students. Nearly 25 students and 10 staff members donated blood. Doctor Rajendra Prasad and his team form Red Cross Society worked here for this programme throughout the day. The volunteers distributed fruits and drinks to the blood donors. The members of the Red Cross Society gave appreciation certificates to the blood donors.







<u>Day 5:- (Bush Cleaning)-05-09-2017</u>

The fifth day of the camp was mainly dedicated to bush cleaning in college premises. NSS volunteers cleaned the bushes present in the college campus nearly 2 or 3 acres of area. 
