## **INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY**


**21-06-2021**



To take care of the training needs of the frontline workers, the Government of India has launched a training module for management of COVID-19 named 'Integrated Govt. Online training' (iGOT) portal on Ministry of HRD's DIKSHA platform for the capacity building of

frontline workers to handle the pandemic efficiently. Courses on iGOT have been launched for Doctors, Nurses, Paramedics, Hygiene Workers, Technicians, Auxiliary Nursing Midwives (ANMs), State Government Officers, Civil Defence Officers, Various Police Organisations, National Cadet Corps (NCC), Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan (NYKS), National Service Scheme, Indian Red Cross Society, Bharat Scouts and Guides and other volunteers. The training contents of the course include Basics of COVID, clinical management, ICU care management, infection prevention and care, usage of PPE, quarantine and isolation, training for NCC cadets, management of COVID- 19 cases, laboratory sample collection and testing, psychological care of patients, paediatric care in COVID, pregnancy during COVID, etc. The new learning content is being regularly added to the modules. Our College NCC cadets have taken part in this platform and 100 cadets have received iGOT certificates.

## **EBSB ONLINE CAMP JAMMU & KASHMIR**


**20-09- 21 TO 25-09-21**


## **2 DAYS CADER**

In this cadets were allowed to Judge Distance, hand signals and field signals were shown to the cadets. 

The B and C Exam cadres were conducted. It is mandatory for NCC cadets to undergo a Combined Annual Training Camp every year to attend the B and C certificate examination to be held in the month of March every year. Drill classes were conducted in the parade ground. Cadets were taught general and words of command, sizing, forming, numbering, open and close order march and dressing. Objectives of NCC were explained, organisation of civil defence and duties were taught to the cadets. Introduction of Map reading was done for the cadets and Field craft and Battle craft was taught to the cadets. The cadets were made to stand in different section formations for better understanding. The cadets were provided with five 7.62mm SLR rifles to give hands on training to learn weapon drill for C cadets on salami shastr, Bhumi shastr, Bagal shastr and Bhaju sastr. B and C Cadets were trained in Kholna and Jodna of the weapon and learnt their parts.





## EARTH DAY
